

# **Development Director Job Description**

### **Position Summary:**

The Democratic Party of Virginia is seeking a highly motivated and organized Development Director to spearhead fundraising for the 2023 election cycle and beyond. Key responsibilities include identifying new income sources, managing call time, planning and executing fundraising events, corresponding with donors, collaborating with other staff to execute the finance plan and budget, and working closely with other Democratic Party of Virginia departments.

This position will report to the Executive Director.

#### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Work with the Chair and Executive Director to maintain and expand the fundraising program;
- Oversee fundraising events of all sizes including but not limited to securing and following up on financial commitments and delegating administrative functions of events including creating invitation materials, tracking RSVPs, coordinating event logistics, staffing events in person, and managing the thank you note process;
- Schedule and execute call time for the Chair and Executive Director, create diligent call-time briefing materials, and ensure timely follow up;
- Identify new fundraising opportunities including new donors and potential new fundraising events;
- Build and maintain relationships with both in-state and national donors;
- Maintain meticulous records of contacts, donations, and event plans; and
- Other duties as assigned.

#### **Desired Skills/Qualifications:**

- Minimum of two to three years of campaign fundraising experience on a political campaign, for a state party or national committee, or for a non-profit organization;
- Excellent interpersonal skills with the ability to work strategically and collaboratively with diverse groups and individuals;
- NGP and ActBlue experience required;
- Strong written and oral communication skills;
- Reliable transportation and the ability/willingness to travel statewide as needed;
- Positive and energetic attitude;
- Superior project management skills multitasking is essential with a demonstrated outcomes oriented approach with the ability to work in a fast-paced, dynamic environment; and
- A strong commitment to Democratic values and equity.
